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## DISCOVER GOVERNOR'S ISLAND

### New National Park in lower Manhattan

For more than two centuries, Governor's Island, located just off the tip of Manhattan, has been off limits and a mystery to the public. In 2003, the National Parks Department was put in charge of overseeing Governor's Island. Its waterfront offers some of the most dramatic vistas of the New York skyline, the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island. Governor's Island was one of the first settlements of the Dutch West India Company in 1624 and became a strategic coastal fortification in the early 1800s for the new American military. In 1909, Wilbur Wright made his first over-water flight from the island and in 1988, it was the site of a summit between President Reagan and Soviet President Gorbachev. From 1776 to 1996, the island had been occupied by the US Army and Coast Guard. The Island is 172 acres with nearly 225 buildings and has been designated as both a National Historic Landmark District and a New York City Historic District. It features late 18th and early 19th century fortifications, pre-Civil War arsenal buildings, and Victorian housing. Fort Jay and Castle Williams can still be seen there today, perfectly intact. Your guided tour of the island will be conducted by Park Rangers aboard our bus. Before we take the ferry to Governor's Island, we'll enjoy a delicious lunch at P.J. Clarke's on the Hudson. Before lunch, we'll visit the National Museum of the American Indian in lower Manhattan and part of the Smithsonian Institution.
