Described as swinging, sexy, smart, and funny, *City of Angels* is an ingenious spoof of 1940s Hollywood and whodunit films. A winner of tons of Tony Awards, it's a witty detective thriller with a jazzy score that really kills. THE RUSSIAN TEA ROOM/ MUSEUM

New York City

For over eighty years, New York's defining cultural moments have taken place at the Russian Tea Room with its dazzling décor that has wowed diners for decades. Ever since members of the Russian Imperial Ballet founded the restaurant in 1927, it has been a second home for celebrity names and the intellectual elite—an exclusive enclave where actors, writers, politicians, and businessmen planned their next deals and feted their friends' latest Carnegie Hall performances. It has maintained the traditional look of the downstairs dining room, with its green and red Russian colors, its fine artwork, and its shining appointments of brass and antique silver samovars. After lunch, we'll visit one of the city's most unique museums, the New York Historical Society, overlooking Central Park West. Founded in 1804 as New York's first museum, this is where four centuries of history, artifacts and art tell the story of America through the eyes of New York.
