Learn about Salem's documented haunted history and the mystery that still surrounds olde Salem — a fascinating journey into Salem's macabre and unusual past.

You'll get chills as you witness the witchcraft hysteria first hand at the Witch Museum. The museum focuses on the Salem Witch Trials of 1692, one of the most emotional events in American History...as fascinating today as it was 300 years ago.

We'll visit The House of Seven Gables. Built in 1668, it is the oldest surviving 17th century wooden mansion in New England, and inspired Nathaniel Hawthorne to write his legendary novel of the same name.

You'll take a journey through New England's grand and storied past at Salem's stunning Peabody Essex Museum, one of the nation's largest museums.

You'll spend some time in the fishing village of Sag Harbor. You'll see the Old Whaler's Church and visit the Sag Harbor Whaling Museum and learn about this one-time whaling port. You'll have free time for sightseeing, shopping, and lunch on your own in Sag Harbor. You'll also visit one of Long Island's best wineries.

On your way out to Montauk, your local tour guide will take you through Southampton, known as an international hot spot for celebrity-watching, dining, shopping and art. Elegant estates, lively nightspots and fashionable boutiques have made the Hamptons a playground for the rich and famous. You'll have some free time to shop and browse the stores in the village of Southampton.
